**Saturday, August 10** - "The Woman of Brown" presented by Donna Rea Pearson, Humanities Kansas This presentation will shine a light on the stories of Twelve Black women who were at the forefront of the civil rights movement as plaintiffs in the landmark Brown v Board of Education case.

**Saturday, November 9** - "Researching Your Home and the People Who Lived There" presented by Diana Staresinic-Deane, Humanities Kansas

This talk shares creative ways to study documents and assemble relevant narratives from maps, deeds, newspapers, and often unsought or unknown resources.
