Take a tour through the *A Child's World* exhibit to see how children of the past entertained themselves. Then stop by the Education Room to test your skills with jacks, spin a top, or shoot some marbles— Games of the non-video variety will be available to anyone who'd like to experience for themselves how children from the parlor to the schoolyard had fun 100 years ago!

All ages are welcome. FREE Admission. Drop in anytime between 1-4pm. Docent-led tours at 1:30, 2:30, and 3:30pm. The activity and tour both take place on the 2nd floor.

Summer Program- Clock-wise: Tower Tour & Activity

Experience behind-the-scenes with a tour of the Museum's clock tower. Did you know the original City Hall building didn't have a clock for 25 years? Try your hand at designing your own clock face for the tower.

All ages are welcome. FREE Admission. Drop in anytime between 1-4pm. Docent-led tours at 1:30, 2:30, and 3:30pm. The take-home activity is on the 2nd floor in the Education Room. The Clock Tower is on the 5th floor.

Cursive Writing Workshops:

Individuals are invited to learn and practice the skill of cursive handwriting. An experienced teacher will guide the letter formation of upper- and lower-case letters and writing your full name. We recommend coming on both days.
